STEFANIE BREHM 2021

WORK

Stefanie Brehm's artistic work is primarily located in the fields of ceramics and plastics. In both materials, the artist combines sculpture with painting. She uses dyed, liquid plastic as a colouring agent, which leads to the creation of a painting that no longer needs any image carrier. The plastic is poured or sprayed millimetre-thin and, after hardening, solidifies into a flat, shiny coloured object that can be applied to walls or glass panes. Smooth, intensely luminous surfaces have a special appeal for Stefanie Brehm.

Thus the ceramic glazes she uses on her human-sized ceramic columns are also colourful and shiny. Working classically on an electric wheel, the production of a human-sized clay column means a several week-long process for the artist, at the end of which the colouring glaze is applied using a spray gun. The work is then fired at over 1240°C in a large ceramic kiln. Due to the high firing temperature, her works are frost-proof and also suitable for outdoor use.

Since 2020, Stefanie Brehm has also been working with flat glass as a surface for painting. As in ceramics, she uses a spray gun to apply the glass colours, which are then fired in the kiln. Due to the transparency of the glass, the powerful colours connect directly with the surroundings.
